



1. Rental Terms & Weight Limits

- Each container rental includes a verbally specified tonnage and rental period, provided at the time of order.
 - Additional rental days will be billed at a daily rate.
 - Rental period resets upon container swap or empty.
 - The maximum container weight is 10 tons. Overweight loads are subject to per-ton charges.

2. Placement & Site Conditions

- Placement Location: Customers may request placement; however, DCW reserves the right to determine final placement for safety, access, and surface protection.
 - Surface Requirements: Containers must be placed on a hard, level surface.
 - Access: Customers must maintain clear and safe access to the container. If blocked or overfilled, a dry run fee will apply.
 - Delivery/Removal Timing: Delivery and removal may occur any time between 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM on the scheduled day. Specific appointment times are not available.

3. Loading Guidelines

- Do Not Overfill: Materials must not extend above the top edge of the container. Overfilled containers will not be serviced.
 - Inspections: DCW inspects all containers at pickup. If unacceptable materials are found, the container will not be removed, and a dry run fee will apply. Pickup must be rescheduled by the customer, and rental time continues.

4. Unacceptable Materials

The following items are strictly prohibited:

- Hazardous waste, liquids, chemicals, oils, solvents, paints, asbestos
- Tires, batteries, electronics, or flammable materials
- Any other materials restricted by local, state, or federal law
